PERSONAL DATA

The operator of this website takes the protection of your personal data very seriously. Your personal data will be treated confidentially and in accordance with the statutory data protection regulations and this privacy policy.

Data

[No personal data is collected on this website,] On the one hand, we collect data on this website that you provide to us voluntarily (for example, by filling out and submitting the contact form). We collect and store all information that you enter on the website via a form or provide in other ways, such as by telephone, e-mail or in person (for example: name, address, telephone number, e-mail address). The data you provide via the form will only be used for the purposes stated in each case (e.g. contacting us). The processing of the data entered in the contact form is therefore based exclusively on your consent (Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a DSGVO). You can revoke this consent at any time. For this purpose, an informal communication by e-mail to us is sufficient. The legality of the data processing operations carried out until the revocation remains unaffected by the revocation.

Other data is automatically collected by our IT systems when you visit the website. This is mainly technical data (e.g. Internet browser, operating system, time of access, IP address). The collection of this data takes place automatically as soon as you enter our website.

Data use and data transmission

We collect the data to be able to process your requests and to ensure the provision of the website. Part of the data may be used to analyze your user behavior.
